### **View Inspection Reports**

The Kansas Department of Agriculture (KDA) is responsible for licensing and inspecting certain types of food establishments statewide (K.S.A. 74-581 et seq.). These food establishments include retail food stores, food processing facilities, food service in retail food stores, mobile ice cream trucks, food vending machines, food vending machine companies and dealers. These food establishments are regulated under the provisions of the Kansas Food Drug and Cosmetic Act and the Kansas Food Service and Lodging Act.
